Effective January 1, 2018

Charge: \$0.30/lb

- Antifreeze
- Adhesive, Water Based
- Ballast
- Batteries, Household
- Caulk/Glaze/Grout/Putty
- Cement/Mortar/Plaster
- Computers, TVs, Electronics
- Cooking Oil/Grease
- Cord Appliances
- Fire Extinguisher
- Latex Paint
- Light bulbs
- Windshield Wiper Fluid

Charge: \$1/unit

- Battery, Automotive (lead acid)

Charge: \$5/unit

- Microwave

Charge: \$15/unit

- Dehumidifier
- Miniature Refrigerator
- Small A/C Unit
- Small Water Cooler

Disposal outlets for additional materials have been developed based on public demand. In order to continue to provide these additional disposal options a small fee is charged.
